FANCY DRESS ACTIVITY

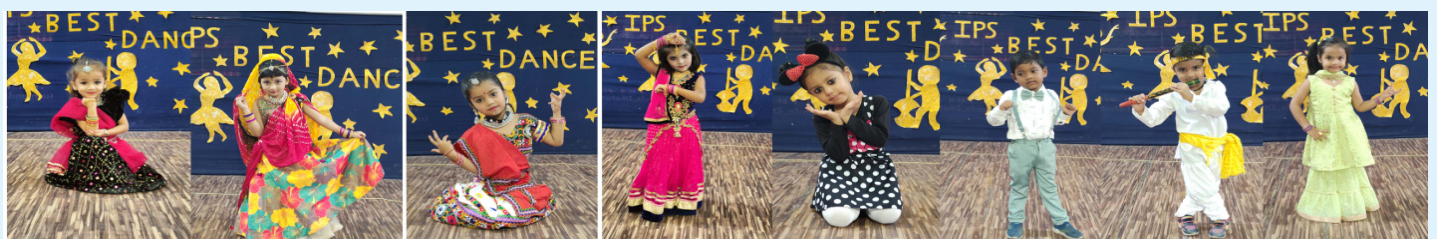


COOKING WITHOUT FIRE

एक आईने की तरह है असफलता ।

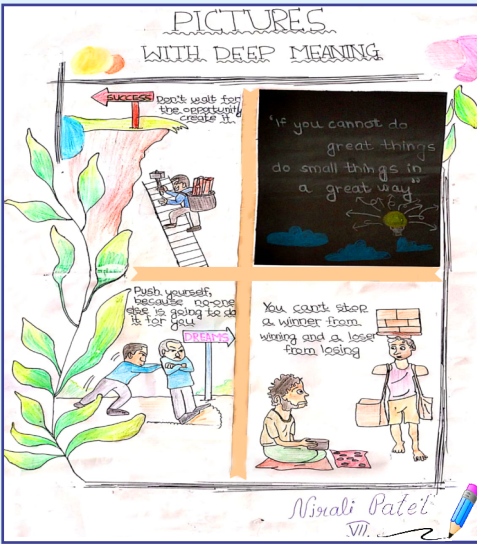
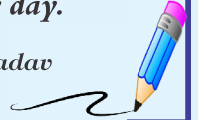
